Psalm 118 is the middle chapter of the entire Bible.
Psalm 118 verse 8 is the middle verse of the entire Bible.

“It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust man”.

1188

Before Psalm 118, Psalm 117 is the shortest chapter in the Bible.

“ Jesus Wept”

After Psalm 118, Psalm 119 is the longest chapter of the Bible.

176 verses

There are 594 chapters before and after Psalm 118. Add $594 + 594 = 1188$.

Number of languages the Bible has been translated into: over 1200

The Old Testament has more than 60 references to Jesus.

The New Testament has more than 260 Old Testament quotations.

The name Christian first appears in Antioch, Syria about 100 AD.

The Gutenberg Bible was printed in August 1456.

Stephen Langton added the Chapters in 1228.

R. Nathan added the verses to the Old Testament in 1488.

Robert Stephanus added the verses to the New Testament in 1551.

The Geneva Bible was the first Bible with Chapters and Verses in 1560.

The First Council of Nicaea

Was convoked by the Roman Emperor Constantine 1st, in 325CE.

The Council, or Synod Canonized the books of the Bible as we know it today.

The list of the Canon was closed by the Council of Carthage in 397CE.
